

TRADITIONAL ARCHERY RULES

7th Conquest Cup Archery Competition will be at Okmeydanı Archers Lodge Sport Facilities between 27-29 of May 2019. The rules of the competition aforementioned are specified below.

CATEGORIES

Target Shooting

Men: 18+ years (birthday earlier and in the year of 2001); 70 meters

Women: 18+ years (birthday earlier and in the year of 2001); 60 meters

Flight Shooting

Primitive Horn Bow Flight Shooting (mixed)

Flight Shooting limited draw weight (50lbs) (mixed)

Flight Shooting unlimited draw weight (Men-Women)

Flight Shooting Siper (mixed)

1. TARGET SHOOTING

Each competitor will shoot 9*7 arrows, a total of 63 arrows to defined distances for the following categories. 9 arrows will be shot for each round.

70m for Individual Men

60m for Individual Women

If the scores are tied according to results of qualification round;

For the 16th place, 2 or more competitors will shoot 1 arrow; the competitor who shoots closer the center of the lower ring will win.

Elimination rounds

According to the results of the qualification rounds from each category, 16 competitors will reach the elimination rounds.

Elimination rounds' results will be done according to the total score of each competitor.

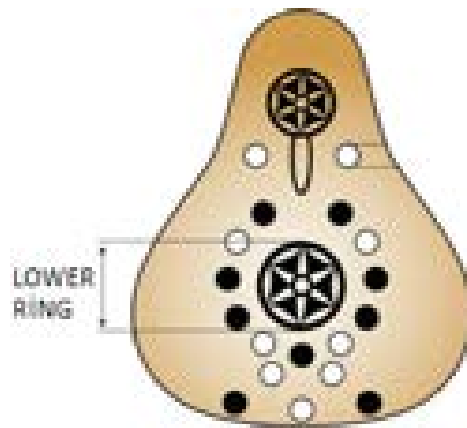
Individual elimination rounds

The competitors will shoot 1 round of 5 arrows, the one who gets the highest score will compete in the next round. This system will be continued until the rankings are determined.

At the end of the rounds, if the scores are tied competitors will shoot 1 arrow; the competitor who shoots closer the center of the lower ring will win.

Target Shooting Puta standards

The size of the Puta is 77*110 cm for all categories and distances unless specified differently. Scores are defined by hit or miss.



2. FLIGHT SHOOTING

Flight shooting competition contains Primitive Bow and Modern Bow categories.

2.1. Primitive Horn Bow (article 5.1.a) FlightShooting

- This category's class is mixed
- The draw weight is unlimited
- A siper can be used.
- The siper, the siper's wearing style and the Muşamba (texture covered on the grip) shall be according to the traditional method.
- The siper can't be at the handle level touching the grip.
- If the equipment is not conforming to regulations determined by the Organizing Committee, it will be disallowed.
- Each competitor will shoot up to 7 arrows.
- Any arrow not anchored into the ground won't be measured. Any arrow identified not anchored because of a rigid surface will be measured.
- If the arrow is broken after being anchored the measurement will be from the tip point.
- Rankings will be arranged according to the farthest distance.
- The competition field will be 70m width.
- Any contestants, who through their inexperience or conduct may constitute a hazard to their fellow contestants or themselves, will not be allowed to compete.
- An arrow is not considered shot if it falls 5m in front of the shooting line.
- If siper is used, competitors must use thumb release style and the arrow must be nocked according the pullingside.
- Competitors shall use only primitive bow detailed in article 5.1.a.

2.2. Limited draw weight (50lbs) Flight Shooting

- This category's class is mixed.
- Draw weight shall be a maximum of 50 lbs (+0.5 lbs)
- The maximum draw weight of the bow is determined when the point of the arrow is drawn over until arrow falls from grip.
- If the equipment is not conforming to regulations determined by the Organizing Committee, it will be disallowed.

- Each competitor will shoot up to 3 arrows.
- Any arrow not anchored into the ground won't be measured. Any arrow identified not anchored because of a rigid surface will be measured.
- If the arrow is broken after being anchored the measurement will be from the tip point.
- Ranking will be arranged according to the farthest distance.
- The competition field will be 70 m width.
- Any contestants, who through their inexperience or conduct may constitute a hazard to their fellow contestants or themselves, will not be allowed to compete.
- An arrow is not considered shot if it falls 5 m in front of the base line.
- Competitors can use modern and primitive horn bow.

2.3. Unlimited draw weight flight shooting

- This category's classes are Women and Men
- The draw weight is unlimited
- The equipment is not conforming to regulations determined by the Organizing Committee will be disallowed.
- Each competitor will shoot up to 5 arrows.
- Any arrow not anchored into the ground won't be measured. Any arrow identified not anchored because of a rigid surface will be measured.
- If the arrow is broken after being anchored the measurement will be from the tip point.
- Rankings will be arranged according to the farthest distance.
- The competition field will be 70 m width.
- Any contestants, who through their inexperience or conduct may constitute a hazard to their fellow contestants or themselves, will not be allowed to compete.
- An arrow is not considered shot if it falls 5 m in front of the shooting line.
- Competitors can use modern and primitive horn bow.

2.4. Siper

- This category's class is mixed
- The draw weight is unlimited
- The siper, the sipers wearing style and the Muşamba (texture covered on the grip) shall be according to the traditional method.
- Siper can't be at the handle level touching to the grip.
- If the equipment is not conforming to regulations determined by the Organizing Committee, it will be disallowed.
- Each competitor will shoot up to 5 arrows.
- Any arrow not anchored into the ground won't be measured. Any arrow identified not anchored because of a rigid surface will be measured.
- If the arrow is broken after being anchored the measurement will be from the tip point.
- Ranking will be arranged according to the farthest distance.
- The competition field will be 70 m width.
- Any contestants, who through their inexperience or conduct may constitute a hazard to their fellow contestants or themselves, will not be allowed to compete.
- An arrow is not considered shot if it falls 5m in front of the shooting line.
- Competitors must use the thumb release style and the arrow must be nocked according to the pulling side.
- Competitors can use modern and primitive horn bow.

3. DRESS REGULATION

Historical clothings shall be worn by the competitors. (jeans, sports shoes etc. are not allowed to wear).

4. RELEASING STYLE

All the Turkish competitors must use the thumb release style and they will nock according to the pulling side.

For all international competitors releasing with fingers are allowed excluding for Primitive Horn bow and Siper flight shooting categories.

5. COMPETITORS' EQUIPMENTS

The specification of the archery competition equipment is detailed below. The form of the bows shall align to historical bow types. In the case of disputation proving that the bow is historically correct is something the archer will need to prove. (pic.1)

5.1. Bow

a) Primitive Horn Bow

The bow shall be made from only natural materials; must be composed of wood, horn, animal sinew and animal glue in traditional form. In the case of disputation proving that the bow is historically correct is something the archer needs to prove. It's forbidden to use bows with a window (grips that can't be modified) or with an arrow rest or any modified grips similar to an arrow rest.

The grip must be at least 15mm thick.

Any aiming facilitating such as sight or any sign, tape etc. is disallowed. The hand holding the grip must not have any sign.

b) Modern Bow

The bow shall be made from any combination of like wood, carbon, carbon-fiber, fiberglass synthetic materials in traditional form. In the case of disputation proving that the bow is historically correct is something the archer will need to prove.

It's forbidden to use bows with a window (grips that can't be modified) or with an arrow rest or any modified grip similar to an arrow rest.

The grip must be at least 15mm thick.

Any aiming facilitating such as sight etc. or any sign, tape etc. are not allowed. On the hand holding the grip shall not have any sign.

5.2. Bow String

The bow string can be made of any color and material. A center string serving may be used with only one düğül (nock point) placed on it. In the stage of full draw, the string serving can not be in the competitor's view. Any sign on the string is not allowed.

5.3. Arrows

Arrows must be made from wood or bamboo. Tip points may be T tip and fit points. Any kind of broadheads is disallowed.

- The fletching of the arrows may be made from natural feathers or paper vanes (not included synthetic materials). The color, the size and the fletching depends on the competitors' choice. Plastic vanes, arrows made from carbon, aluminium or fibreglas are disallowed.
- Self nock or natural nocks must be used. Plastic nocks are disallowed.
- Arrows may be painted 10cm only from the end of the fletching. The nock, any other place on the shaft and underneath the fletches can not be painted.
- Competitors must write their names and surnames on their arrows.

6. PERSONAL SUPPLIES

6.1. Thumbring (Zihgir), shooting gloves must be made from natural materials according to the traditional method. Any mechanical devices are disallowed for release aid.

6.2. Quivers must be made according to the traditional method.

6.3. Armguard must be made according to the traditional method.

6.4. Binoculars may be used by an assistant or an advisor. Prescription glasses may be used. Any lenses helping aiming or sun glasses are disallowed.

6.5. Siper must be made according to traditional method. The siper must have 3 parts:

Tasma: a wrist strap must be made from leather or texture placed under the siper plate.

Oluk: the groove must be made from natural materials (e.g. Bone, horn etc.)

Tabla: the plate placed under the groove must be made from natural materials (e.g. Bone, horn etc.) and it can be covered by leather or texture.

6.6. Muşamba (texture covered on the grip) should be made with waxed texture. Any other material can't be covered under the Muşamba.

7. SHOOTING RULES

- 3 minutes (180s) are given for 9 arrows for each competitor.
- An arrow shot before the start signal or after the stop signal, or more than the specified number of arrows, will cause the competitor to lose the highest scoring arrow.
- No competitor may shoot at the end of the official shooting (practice round or after collecting) otherwise it will cause the competitor to lose the highest score of the next round.
- While shooting, if a health problem occurs; preventing the competitor's participation in shooting, the medical team will examine and report if the competitor is allowed to continue within 15 min. should the competitor be allowed to continue shooting, they will shoot the remaining arrows under the supervision of a judge.
- In the event of an equipment failure the competitor must call a Judge while stepping back to the waiting line. Adjustments will be made within 15 min. should the competitor be allowed to continue shooting, they will shoot the remaining arrows under the supervision of a judge.
- The order of shooting may be changed temporarily for the purpose of equipment repair or for medical treatment.
- Competitors may not draw the bow until the signal to start shooting has been given.
- Under no circumstances may an arrow be re-shot. An arrow may be considered not to have been shot if:
 - The arrow falls from the bow or is mis-shot and a part of the arrow shaft lies within the zone between the shooting line and the 3m line, and provided the arrow has not rebounded;
 - The target face blows over. The Judges shall take whatever measures they deem necessary, and compensate adequate time for shooting the relevant number of arrows. If the target face only slides down, it shall be left to the Judges to decide what action to take, if any.

- No competitor may touch the equipment of another without the latter's consent.
- No smoking, including use of electronic cigarettes, is allowed in or in front of the competitors' area.
- The Director of Shooting shall be advised if a competitor, when drawing back the string of his bow uses any technique which, in the opinion of the Judges, could allow the arrow, if accidentally released, to fly beyond a safety zone or safety arrangements (overshoot area, net, wall etc.). If a competitor persists in using such a technique, he shall, in the interest of safety, be asked by the Chairperson of the Tournament Judge Commission or the Director of Shooting to stop shooting immediately and to leave the field.
- No competitor may draw his bow, with or without an arrow, except when standing on the shooting line.

8. PRACTICE SHOOTING

Practice shooting rounds are within the official shooting rounds. The time for practice is decided by the Organizing Committee and is informed to all participant clubs' directors. All practice arrows shall be shot under the control of the Judges. No competitor is allowed to practice after the stop sign has been given by the judge.

9. ORDER OF SHOOTING AND TIMING CONTROL

Order of shooting and timing control shall be arranged in the following way:

9.1 If four competitors shoot in pairs on a target, the rotation shall be AB-CD.

9.2. In the event of three or four competitors shoot at the same time the position on the shooting line may be decided by competitors. If there is no agreement the positions shall be as follows when two, three or four competitors shoot at the same target face:

- competitor A shall shoot on the left, B on the right;
- competitor A shall shoot on the left, B in the middle and C on the right;

- Competitor A and C shall shoot on the left and B and D on the right where AB and CD shoot alternately.

10. SCORING

- An arrow shall be scored according to the position of the shaft in the target face. If the shaft of an arrow touches any dividing lines between two scoring zones, that arrow shall score the higher value of the two zones involved.
- None of the arrows, the target face shall be touched until the value of all the arrows on that target has been recorded.
- If more than the required number of arrows should be found in the target the highest scores for the quantity of extra arrows won't be counted. Competitor or teams found to repeat this offence may be disqualified.
- If a fragment of a target face is missing, including the dividing line or if the dividing line is pushed aside by an arrow, then an imaginary circular line shall be used for judging the value of any arrow that hits such a part.
- At the end of the qualification round, if the scores are tied competitors will shoot 1 arrow; the competitor who shoots closer the center of the lower ring will win.
- A competitor may choose only 2 categories. (e.g. : Target shooting and one flight shooting category or 2 different flight shooting categories)
- A bow can't be used by more than one competitor in the flight shooting categories.

11. For International tournament participants all accommodation and travel expenses will be provided by Organizing Committee including local transfers (From/To Hotel-Air- port and From/To Hotel-Field).

12. In the event of an appeal, a request shall be written and 200TL payed on Okçular Vakfı Spor club's account. If the appeal is eligible the payment will be payed back.

13. International foreign competitors' number is limited to 4 for each country and each class (women-men). Total number of target competitors, (for all foreign competitors) shall be 64 individual men and 32 individual women. Priority will be given according to success of 6th Conquest Cup.



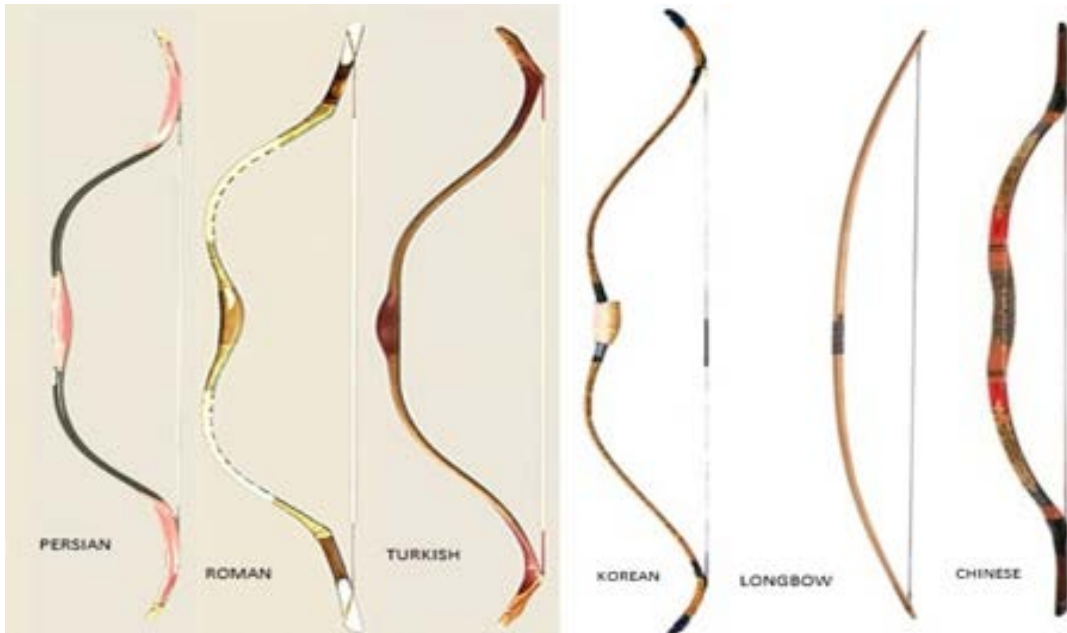

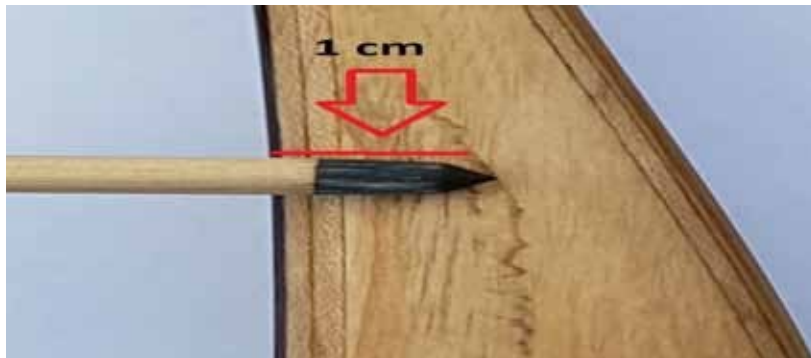


Information about limited draw weight flight shooting category's bow measurement mentioned in the article 2.2. of the 6th Conquest Cup reglement.

- In this category draw weight must be a maximum of 50 lbs (+0.5 lbs)



- The maximum draw weight of the bow is determined when the point of the arrow is drawn over until arrow falls from grip.



The bow must be measured as above. Example: If the bow's draw weight is 50lbs at 71cm using the measurement specified above then you must use an arrow that is 71cm. The organization committee is not responsible for any damages may occur during the measurements.
